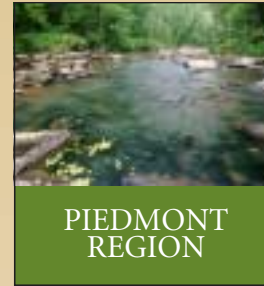

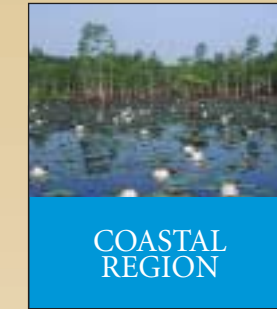

Palau, Micronesia

Through a partnership with the Palau Conservation Society, the Conservancy is working to protect one of the world’s underwater wonders—the coral reefs of Palau. Home to more than 1,400 species of fish and 625 species of coral, this island republic is one of the world’s top dive destinations.

Canaima National Park, Venezuela

Cerulean warblers and summer tanagers that nest in the steamy swamps of North Carolina’s lower Roanoke River floodplain spend their winters in an equally exotic location – Canaima National Park in Venezuela. Many neotropical migratory birds flock to this seven million-acre park every year.
